Re: Positive Covid-19 Case

We want to thank everyone for your cooperation and diligence during the pandemic and for maintaining a safe work environment at Kramer Beverage. Unfortunately, we were informed this morning by the Atlantic County Health Department that we have had our first Kramer Beverage employee test positive for COVID-19.

An employee, in Hammonton, who was last in the facility on Tuesday, May 26 has tested positive. We are in direct contact with this employee to monitor their health and provide support where possible. Based on the current CDC guidelines of a 48-hour look back from the first onset of symptoms, we were able to watch video footage to review the locations of this individual in the building and saw no evidence that there was exposure to any other employee. We are fortunate that our safety precautions, social distancing, wearing masks and gloves, and being vigilant with cleanliness have helped prevent any other employees from being at risk. Continuing these practices will help reduce further risk. All cleaning protocols have been completed and will be on-going. We cannot disclose the name of this individual due to privacy protection laws.
