Re: Vaccine Availability

We continue to encourage all employees to receive the COVID-19 vaccine as soon as they are eligible and are able to obtain an appointment. We provide \$50 per shot administered to all employees who submit a copy of their CDC Covid-19 Vaccine Record Card.

To sign up in <u>New Jersey</u>, go to <u>https://covidvaccine.nj.gov/</u>. When the vaccine is available, and you are eligible, they should send you a text/email to make an appointment with a list of locations.

In addition to those listed. CVS, Rite Aid, and Walgreens will be handling vaccines. Rite Aid is working with the New Jersey registry only, and Walgreens will be taking direct appointments soon.

- Not yet taking appointments but coming soon. You must sign in to the site to register.

Rite Aid

• Only being scheduled through the New Jersey sign up system.

- The site is opening up more appointments. The system will tell you how many people are ahead of you and how many appointments are available.
- Vaccine scheduling will be open weekly on the following days and times:
 - Tuesdays at 3 p.m.
 - Thursdays at 6 p.m.
 - Saturdays at 9 a.m.

It is recommended for all self-registration sites that you go on ahead of the scheduled time to be put into their queue to select an appointment. It is also best to register for that site ahead of time. Please note that the wait times can be quite long.
