





Operating System & Software Upgrades

Apple, Microsoft, and other software developers are constantly providing upgrades to their software & operating systems. Apple just released iOS 17 and we are always asked should I install the upgrade? I say YES.

While we may direct you to hold off on an upgrade to work iPads, I would recommend that your personal devices and applications should be kept at the newest releases (also known as patching).
