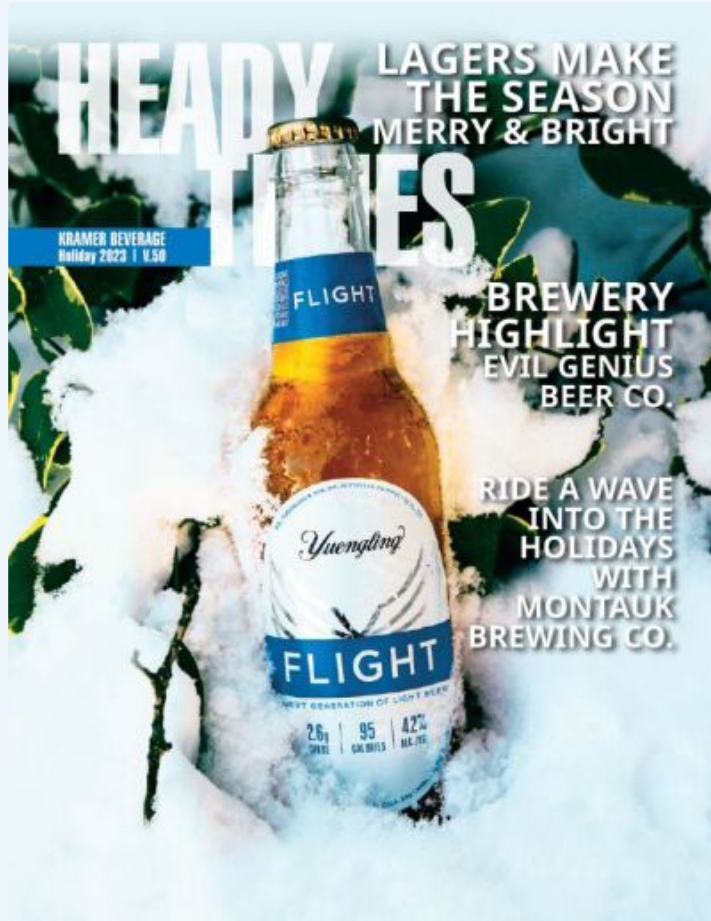

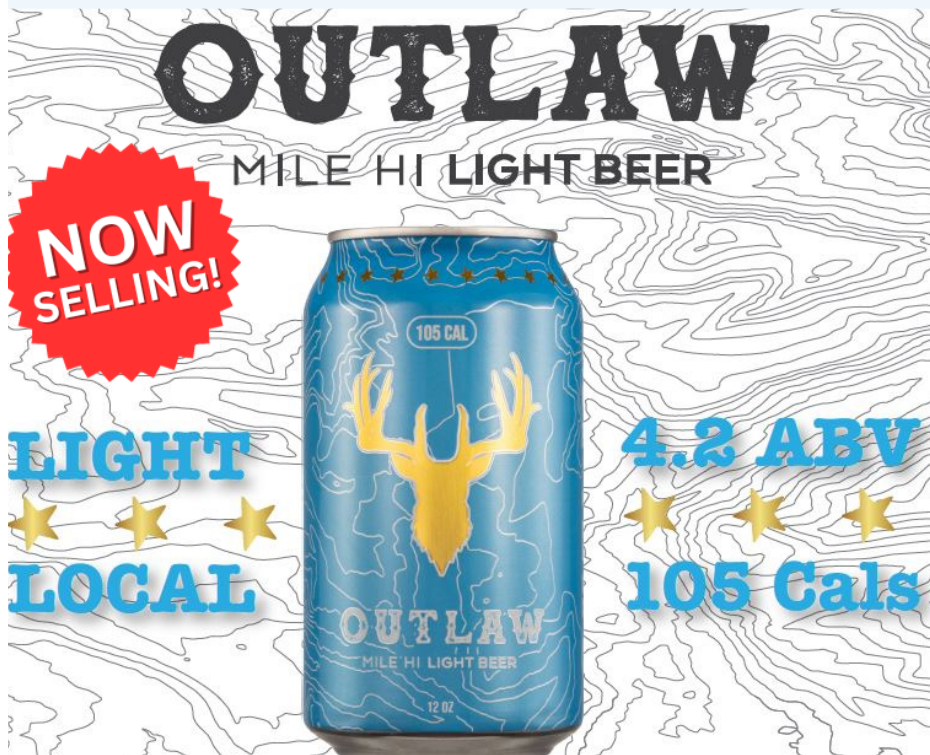

Phishing & SPAM Texts

More and more, we are all getting phishing and spam e-mails, but now they are hitting our text messaging too!

While Kramer Beverage works on clearing up your company inbox, you can do something to clear up your text messages. Of course, you can block the message sender, ignore & delete, but you can also strike back. Before deleting the text, use the app's "Report Junk" feature or forward the text to 7726 (SPAM). By reporting the transgression, the GSMA (A Global mobile phone association) will work with cellular carriers to block the sender.

So, remember to **REPORT** before deleting & blocking. Also, commercial communications are **NOT** phishing and spam, so just unsubscribe to them, and don't report them.
